

Open- ended resources:

- Sheets, blankets, drapes, material ,netting
- clips and pegs
- large boxes
- canes, sticks
- Collections of objects – bowls, brushes, spoons, bottles and caps, sieves
- Collections of natural objects – autumn leaves, turf, gravel, shells and stones, seeds
- Treasure boxes
- Sensory experiences – ‘smelly’ items, crunchy materials, crinkly materials
- Guttering, tubes, tyres, crates, wheels, planks and wooden boxes
- Small containers, pipettes, syringes, tubing for sand and water play
- Percussion instruments
- Objects that make a noise
- Scarves and ribbons, variety of soft ,floaty fabrics
- Mirrors – different sizes, handheld, convex, concave, bendable
- Tins, tubes, objects that roll
- Working devices -- camera, telephone, torch, Dictaphone, microphone, programmable toy
- Bricks, blocks, different shapes and sizes, including cardboard, wood, soft etc.
- Sand, water, gloop, mud, clay, dough etc. with large range of accessories. Chances to add water to things to mix in and with
- Range of opening boxes with things to put inside. Some opening and closing
- Recycled objects
- Objects with handles
- Objects from real life - from kitchen, bathroom, various lids, keys, pots and pans, bags and purses, jewellery, chains, scourers
- Balls of wool, string, elastic
- Small items such as beads, jewel stones, pebbles, buttons
- Selection of baskets with and without handles
- Pieces of tubing and hosing
- Various size logs/wood
