Our focus words for children to talk about at home during conversations are feeling words are Worried, Happy, Sad, excited, Surprised frightened. How is your child feeling when they are doing something or going somewhere?

Can your child make a pattern with objects, colours or shapes, this can be done anywhere around the house with toys, household objects, pens, pencils etc.

World book day 3rd March 2022 Can your child bring in their favourite book at home for all the children to share the stories for the whole week between the 28th Feb and the 4th March. Thank you.

Can your child recognise a group of objects starting with 2 then move on up to a number your child is easily able to identify. **Can you record anything you have achieved or had ago at with your child in their home communication book.** Thank you, this will really help to connect home with Little Bears Pre-school.
